Akademia Pomorska w Słupsku operates pursuant to: the Regulation of the Board of Ministers of 19 June 1969 on setting up higher teacher schools in Bydgoszcz, Kielce, Olsztyn and Słupsk (Journal of Laws No. 18, item 134), the Regulation of the Board of Ministers of 20 August 1974 on transforming Wyższa Szkoła Nauczycielska w Słupsku into Wyższa Szkoła Pedagogiczna w Słupsku (Journal of Laws No. 30, item 177), the Act of 7 June 2000 on giving Wyższa Szkoła Pedagogiczna w Słupsku the name Pomorska Akademia Pedagogiczna w Słupsku (Journal of Laws No. 60, item 697), the Act of 18 October 2006 on giving new names to some public universities (Journal of Laws No. 202, item 1483), the Act of 27 July 2005 on the Law on Higher Education (Journal of Laws No. 164, item 1365). It is a state (public) university. It is authorised to grant the title of doctor of humanities (doktor nauk humanistycznych) in the field of literary studies, the title of doctor of humanities (doktor nauk humanistycznych) in the field of history, the doctor of biological sciences (doktor nauk biologicznych) in the field of biology and the doctor of social sciences in the field of security sciences (doktor nauk społecznych w dyscyplinie nauki o bezpieczeństwie).

The grade point average is calculated according to the following rules:

1) grade point average for each term is the arithmetic mean in all subjects grades acquired during the term;
2) grade point average for each academic year is the arithmetic mean in all subjects grades acquired in two terms;

3) grade point average of the completed course of studies is the arithmetic mean in all subjects grades.

All arithmetic means are accurate to the second decimal point without rounding.

The study is completed after passing the qualification examination with positive mark. The date of completion of study is the date on which the final qualification examination is passed. However, the date of completion of Physiotherapy course is the date of the last internship as required by the study programme.

1. The final mark of the second cycle study programme and one cycle master's degree study programme is the sum of:

- 0,45 of the arithmetic mean of all grades in a given course,
- 0,35 of the final master's degree thesis mark,
- 0,20 of the final qualification examination mark.

2. The final mark of the first cycle study programme is the sum of:

- 0,5 of the arithmetic mean of all grades in a given course,
- 0,3 of the final undergraduate's/engineer's thesis mark
- 0,2 of the final qualification examination mark.

3. The final mark of the first cycle study programme which does not include writing the final thesis is the sum of:

- 0,5 of the arithmetic mean of all grades in a given course,
- 0,5 of the final qualification examination mark.

8. INFORMATION ON THE HIGHER-EDUCATION SYSTEM IN POLAND

8.1. Access to higher education

The total duration of education until completion of a school offering the opportunity to take the secondary school-leaving examination (*egzamin maturalny*) is 12-15 years. Having successfully passed the examination, alumni are awarded a secondary school-leaving certificate (*świadectwo dojrzałości*), which entitles them to apply for admission to a higher-education institution.

8.2. Higher-education system

The Polish higher-education system operates on the basis of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on higher education and science (Journal of Laws, item 1668 as amended).

Public higher-education institutions are established by a state body. Studies at higher-education institutions are conducted as first-cycle, second-cycle or one-cycle master's degree programmes, and may be offered in a full-time or a part-time mode.

Full-time first-cycle programmes last at least six semesters, or at least seven semesters if the curriculum includes learning outcomes that enable students to develop engineering competences. Full-time second-cycle programmes last 3-5 semesters. Full-time one-cycle master's degree programmes last 9-12 semesters. Part-time programmes may last longer than equivalent full-time programmes.

Qualifications obtained on completion of studies as part of the higher-education system are assigned a Polish Qualifications Framework level specified by the Act of 22 December 2015 on the Integrated Qualifications System (Journal of Laws 2018, item 2153, as amended).

A diploma of first-cycle studies certifies obtaining a full qualification at level 6 of the Polish Qualifications Framework.

A diploma of second-cycle studies and a diploma of one-cycle master's degree studies certify obtaining a full qualification at level 7 of the Polish Qualifications Framework.

8.3. Titles awarded to graduates of higher-education institutions

- 1) *licencjat, inżynier* and equivalent titles, such as *inżynier architekt, inżynier pożarnictwa, licencjat pielęgniarstwa* and *licencjat położnictwa*, are awarded to graduates of first-cycle programmes,
- 2) *magister, magister inżynier* and equivalent titles, such as
 - a) *magister inżynier architekt, magister inżynier pożarnictwa, magister pielęgniarstwa, and magister położnictwa* are awarded to graduates of second-cycle programmes,
 - b) *lekarz, lekarz dentysta, lekarz weterynarii, magister farmacji and magister inżynier architekt*, are awarded to graduates of one-cycle master's degree programmes.

8.4. ECTS

To receive a diploma of first-cycle studies, the student is required to obtain at least 180 ECTS credits; to receive a diploma of second-cycle studies – at least 90 ECTS credits; to receive a diploma of one-cycle master's degree studies, the student is required to obtain at least 300 ECTS credits if the programme lasts 9 or 10 semesters, or least 360 ECTS credits if it lasts 11 or 12 semesters.
